The Exhibition "Beyond Caravaggio" will open on 12 October at the National Gallery. Discussing the greatest artist of the Italian Baroque and presenting the paintings which could not be lent for the exhibition, such as the amazing "Deposition of Christ" in the Vatican Museum, St Mathews' 3 paintings in the Contarelli Chapel in Rome and "the Santa Lucia" in Syracuse will be interesting and will put the Exhibition in London in the context of Caravaggio's influence on the European scene. It was short lived, just like Caravaggio's life, in fact after 1650 his art was out of fashion and neglected. Later in the 19 C. his influence on European Art, called Caravaggism, was understood and fully admired.
