The Romans' passion for fine dining is well-known – now a mouth-watering new exhibition at the Ashmolean Museum shows how the production, distribution and consumption for food and wine coloured every aspect of Roman life, as its curator Paul Roberts explains

Bon viveurs interested in Roman culture are blessed by the large amount of evidence from Roman writers, who seem to have been particularly interested in food and drink – and all this involved. Now, in Last Supper in Pompeii, a fantastic exhibition at the Ashmolean Museum, new archaeological research on the subject both from Italy and Britain is presented.

At the beginning of the Ashmolean exhibition, powerful objects flag up its major themes. A fine marble statue of the wine god Bacchus underlines from the start the crucial importance of the gods to every aspect of food and drink.
